I bring a few items to your attention for the new term:

- Matrics have a very short time left before the final exams. Parents need to encourage their children to stay focussed and work hard. Extra effort will be needed if they wish to excel. - Parents are reminded that school accounts need to be up to date prior to the end of term. Learners with overdue fees will NOT receive their reports and not be able to return to school until their account has been settled. **Thank you** to all parents who faithfully keep their accounts up to date.
- All foreign students must ensure that their visas are up to date and copies dropped off at Reception.
- We encourage you to support your child and your school by ensuring children return to school timeously in order for the education process to proceed immediately, with little disruption. A late penalty fee of R250 will be charged to parents' accounts if learners arrive after the official start date (Tuesday, 19th July). Please make sure that boys are clean shaven and all learners' hair is according to school rules.
- On **Friday, 24th June 2022**, the last day of school, the reports will be handed from **8:00 until 10:00**. Those learners who do not collect their reports, may collect them on the 1st day of the new term as we will not be posting or emailing reports. Please be aware that your child will be issued with a report that will be according to the requirements of the Department of Education, and will not reflect the exam marks only. In the interest of our learners to remain used to a full-scale exam, we wrote one, even though the Department did not require it.
