## **MATRICS**

We share with great excitement the achievements of our matric learners from 2022, Declan Wildeman (7 distinctions), Ryan and Jordan Hobbs both with 5 distinctions. Twenty-five (25) of the thirty (30) learners achieved a bachelor's certificate (83%). A 100% pass rate was achieved with 35 subject A's, 39 subject B's, only 3 learners received a Higher Certificate. We are very proud of each of these learners and would like to encourage our current Grade 12's to commit to a dedicated work ethic from day one this year.

### PT

All learners have been issued with timetables for their PT periods. PT uniform is a pair of **black** shorts or **black** track suit pants, with a **white T-shirt**. Girls are required to wear full bathing costumes; board shorts may be worn over them. Parents, please note that PT is part of the required Life Orientation programme of every learner. If your child is unable to take part in PT, for health reasons, a doctor's certificate must be provided.
