Shoes	<ul> <li>Only black school shoes that can be polished may be worn.</li> <li>No tekkies or pumps are allowed.</li> <li>Matrics are not exempted from this rule</li> </ul>	
Jewellery	<ul> <li>No jewellery at school</li> <li>This includes earrings, rings, necklaces, nose rings, belly rings, bangles, bits of string/leather</li> <li>No plasters covering piercings will be allowed, have piercings done during the holidays.</li> <li>Plastic posts are allowed, but should be clear plastic and hardly visible.</li> </ul>

Assembly	<ul> <li>Rain jackets may NOT be worn in assembly, blazers are compulsory on Mondays for assembly</li> <li>Matrics must wear their matric jackets when they have received them, otherwise they must wear their blazer</li> </ul>	
Civvies	<ul> <li>No revealing necklines/midriffs, short shorts or short skirts</li> <li>No offensive imagery or slogans</li> <li>Rules for <u>jewellery</u>, <u>hair</u> and <u>nails</u> still apply</li> </ul>

Bathing costume	Navy-blue or black	
Sport shirt	Red or black Helder or Bergie when advis	sed of your team – white t-shirt until then
